After many months of effort, the sign is in place! In preparation for Norfolk OpSail 2012, the War of 1812 Bicentenial, christening and commissioning of NOAA ship Ferdinand R. Hassler, and a weekend Open House, the Marine Operations Center Atlantic completed the installation of the educational sign, "NOAA Charts Its Beginnings to 1807". The weekend after installation, an estimated 1,000 visitors entered the gates next to the newly installed sign; several of which commented they had no idea that NOAA had such a long history. The sign is located outside the gate of the Marine Operations Center and viewable to all pedestrians and people riding the light rail to increase public awareness for many years to come!
